- ✓ Install, maintain, inspect, and repair electrical systems inside and outside of buildings.
- ✓ Perform all work in accordance with applicable safety policies and code requirements.
- ✓ Establish and coordinate electrical preventive maintenance program.
- ✓ Work with wiring details per specifications.
- ✓ Assist with other Department needs, including but not limited to snow and ice control: snow plowing, salting, and sidewalk clearing.
- ✓ Other duties as assigned.

Qualified candidates should...

- ✓ Have a high school diploma or GED equivalent; bachelor's degree preferred.
- ✓ Have a State of Illinois Class B Commercial (CDL) driver's license with airbrake endorsement (or acquire it within 6 months)
- ✓ Have an electrical license in the State of Illinois.
- ✓ Have specialized training on electrical systems.
- ✓ Have a minimum five (5) years of experience at a journey level in the installation, maintenance, and repair of large, complex electrical systems.
- ✓ Have experience with low voltage systems, including but not limited to security, data, and communication systems.
- ✓ Be able to exert up to 75 pounds of force occasionally and up to 50 pounds of force frequently.
- ✓ Be able to work in a setting that is highly variable and is subject to changing weather conditions, noise vibrations, moving parts, and electrical equipment.
- ✓ Be able to work Monday - Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. with evening and weekend hours, as required. Must be able to work overtime on short notice and have 24-hour on-call availability.
